Fire, Rescue, and Emergency Medical Operations

- For the period of 11/1/2013 to 11/30/2013 TCFD responded to 202 emergency calls for service:
 - 136 emergency medical related responses
 - 6 structure fires
 - 10 smoke / odor investigations
 - 19 alarm activation
 - 5 natural gas leaks / power lines down
 - 2 grass fires
 - 1 hazardous materials
 - 1 rescue
 - 22 misc. fire assignments
