**Subject:** Criminal Investigation Division's 1<sup>st</sup> Narc Search Warrant of 2013

On Sunday, January 20 2013, The Colony Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division served their first Narcotics Search Warrant on 2013 in the 5200 block of Gates Dr. Narcotics detectives through undercover operations infiltrated illegal prescription drugs sales that occurred at the residence. Detectives determined that Dany Solaka, 22 years of age, illegally sold prescription drugs out of the home. The search warrant yielded several different types of prescription drugs that are illegal to possess without a legitimate prescription. Some of the prescription drugs included Xanax, Phentermine, Hydrocodone, and Clorazepam. Mr. Solaka was arrested during the search warrant and charged with the following:

- Two Counts of Manufacture/Delivery of Controlled Substances Penalty Group 3.
- One Count of Possession of Controlled Substances Penalty Group 1.



The charges are all felonies, but because the residence is situated in a state designated "drug free zone", all charges are enhanced one degree higher. Mr. Solaka was booked in The Colony Jail, where he was later arraigned and bail was set at \$180,000.00. Additional charges of Prescription Fraud are anticipated, but the investigation for those charges is still ongoing.
