## **Drop-off for limbs, branches starts Saturday**

THE COLONY, Texas — As of Monday, trash and recycling schedules were caught up following delays resulting from recent inclement weather. Service has resumed as normal.

Additionally, there are many homes and businesses with tree limbs and branches that need removal. Residents are asked to utilize the city's normal bulk and green waste procedures, which includes limitations on the amount that may be collected. Further details of the procedures are available on the city's website under the Solid Waste and Recycling departmental tab.

Residents also may drop off larger amounts of limbs and branches for disposal starting this weekend, Saturday, Dec. 14, in the designated area at the Hawaiian Falls parking lot. No bulk items please. The drop-off location will be available daily through Sunday, Dec. 22.
