## **Wildscaping class set for Saturday, June 21**

THE COLONY, Texas — In conjunction with Keep The Colony Beautiful, Texas Master Naturalist and The Colony resident Donna Cole will be offering a Wildscaping 101 class from 10 a.m. to noon Saturday, June 21 at City Hall, 6800 Main St.

Wildscaping is landscaping for wildlife, but it benefits everyone. By attending this course, you may learn how to attract the wildlife you want to your yard, whether it's birds, mammals, insects or amphibians, using easy-to-grow native plants.

The class will discuss designing and planning the wildscape, plants and local sources, resources and examples. You don't have to have a yard, either – Wildscapes can be grown in containers on patios and balconies. You can also learn how to get your Wildscape certified by the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department and the National Wildlife Federation.
