Filing period for November election begins

THE COLONY, Texas — The Colony City Council will hold its General Election for single-member council districts on Nov. 4. This year, Places 3, 4, 5 and 6 are up for election for three-year terms.

The filing period of the November city council election begins next week. A new page on the city's website has been launched that provides useful information for prospective candidates and will be updated throughout the election cycle to include applications and other documentation turned in by the candidates.

The webpage also outlines the district boundaries, which are different from those currently existing following the council's approval of a redistricting map in 2013. Each candidate applying to run for a particular council place must reside within that place or district.

The first day to apply for a place on the ballot is Saturday, July 19. However, the City Secretary's Office will not be open until the next business day, which is Monday, July 21. The last day to file is 5 p.m. Aug. 18. Applications may be presented in person or by mail before the deadline at the City Secretary's Office, City Hall, 6800 Main St., The Colony, TX 75056.

The Application Packet may be obtained from the City Secretary's Office. Application packets can be picked up at any time during normal business hours or printed from the webpage.
