## **Traffic signal at Lake Highlands operational week of Nov. 9**

**UPDATE (Jan. 5, 2016)** – This traffic light will remain flashing yellow/red until the completion of the Main Street Widening Project so its timing can be set in conjunction with the other lights up and down Main Street.

THE COLONY, Texas — As part of an effort to keep residents informed, officials with the City of The Colony are in continuous contact with representatives from the Texas Department of Transportation regarding the progress of the Main Street Widening Project.

In addition to lane closures, we feel it important to provide residents with notices of traffic switches because lanes may be configured differently than the last time you drove them. Motorists are encouraged to focus on the roadway in order to avoid accidents from being in the wrong lane.

Upcoming or ongoing switches are listed below. *You may need to refresh your browser to view the most-current document.*

### **Traffic Switch**

**The following roadwork is scheduled for Nov. 9-10, weather permitting:**

- lanes will be shifted at the intersection of Main Street and Lake Highlands Drive to facilitate removal of the universal center turn lanes and conversion to dedicated left-turn lanes at the intersection; as of Monday, **Nov. 2**, the signal will begin flashing yellow to north- and southbound drivers while flashing red to drivers heading east- or westbound; signal anticipated to be fully operational the week of **Nov. 9**; motorists should expect delays as TxDOT works to adjust the signal's timing in concert with the other signals on Main Street during the initial time period following installation.
