## **News Release**

**On Thursday afternoon, August 26, 2010, at around 5:00pm, The Colony Police Department responded to a call at 20400 Hackberry Rd, Hidden Cove Park, on a report of a female subject stabbing a male repeatedly with an ice pick.**

**As police and fire units arrived on scene, they observed the victim laying in the tall grass and weeds near the roadway in a secluded area of the park that leads to camping cabins. The female suspect was still at the scene having been detained by two witnesses and fire department personnel who had arrived on scene prior to police arrival.**

**Two Hidden Cove Park employees, who were driving the road in their work truck, happened on the scene and witnessed the female repeatedly stabbing the victim as she straddled him. They yelled at her to stop as they approached her and she stood up and walked away from the victim.**

**The male victim was found to be severely wounded with life threatening injuries from numerous stab wounds. He was transported to Baylor Carrollton Hospital in Carrollton, Tx. where he died of his injuries.**

**The female suspect was arrested at the scene and charged with Murder. She was taken to Baylor Hospital as well for treatment to cuts to her hands sustained during the crime and later booked into The Colony Jail to await arraignment.**

**A pair of bloody scissors found at the scene is believed to be the murder weapon.**

**At the time of this release, there is no known motive or information as to the relationship between the victim and suspect. Their names are also not being released until notification of family members can be accomplished.**
