SUBJECT: Two Search Warrants Served within a Week

The Colony Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division, along with The Special Response Team served two search warrants within a week in a continuing effort to curtail drug activity in The Colony. The first warrant was served on 06/26/09 at a residence in the 5500 blk of Russell Drive. Narcotics detectives infiltrated drug activity at that location and obtained several arrests warrants against two individuals residing there.

Arrested were:

Alexander Italia = One count of delivery of controlled substance (Xanax), four counts of delivery of marijuana, and Mr. Italia also had a outstanding Denton County warrant for probation violation. \$37,000.00 Total bond set.

Leticia Romero = One count of delivery of controlled substance (Xanax), four counts of delivery of marijuana, and Ms. Romero also had a outstanding Denton County warrant for probation violation. \$43,504.00 Total bond set.

- Both individuals were later transferred to Denton County Jail.

The next search warrant was executed on 06/29/2009 by The Colony Police Detectives and the Colony Special Response team in the early morning hours at a residence in the 1400 blk of Witt Road in Little Elm. Once again, narcotics detectives infiltrated drug activity at this location which showed to be supplying drugs to users in The Colony. Police Detectives obtained an arrest/search warrant for a female subject that resided at that location. After the search/arrest warrant was served it was learned that the female subject was recently evicted from the residence and not present. The Colony Police still has an outstanding warrant for **Trista Ballard**, wanted for Delivery of Marijuana.

No one was injured in either of the warrants that were executed.
