SUBJECT: Three Search Warrants Executed in Two Days

The Colony Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division and The Colony Special Response Team were busy last week executing three search warrants in two days. In their continuing effort to curtail drug activity within the city limits, narcotics detectives infiltrated three different homes that were either selling narcotics or were supplying local individuals.

On September 9, 2009 in the early morning hours, a narcotics search warrant was executed in the 6300 Block of Jennings Dr. During the search of the residence marijuana was located. Howard Barry and Ashley Lively, both from The Colony, were arrested for possession of marijuana.

Also on September 9, 2009 in the afternoon a narcotics search warrant was executed at a residence, located in the 5700 Block of Baker Dr. During a search of the residence marijuana was located. Natividad Meraz Jr. of The Colony and Kurtis Staley of Little Elm were arrested for possession of marijuana.

On September 10, 2009, in the early morning hours a narcotics search warrant was executed at in the 5000 Block of Stanley. During a search of the residence hashish was located, along with heroine and numerous other drug related paraphernalia. Justin Whitlock and Sabrenah Mendoza were arrested for possession of controlled substance in penalty group 2 (heroine).

All individuals were transported to The Colony Jail, where they were later arraigned. As a result of each warrant executed, further charges may be forthcoming. All arrests occurred without incident.
