SUBJECT: Advisory for Ecstasy Pills Made to Look Like Vitamins

The Colony Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division wants to send an advisory out to the citizens and make them aware of a new look for ecstasy pills. Recently detectives have seized several ecstasy pills that were made to look like children's vitamins. The last batch of pills seized looked very similar to the popular "Transformers" action figure vitamins. Other pills looked similar to the Flintstone's children vitamins. Parents are urged to talk to their kids about this in order to prevent an accidental ingestion. Ecstasy usually comes in a tablet form that is often branded, (e.g. Playboy bunnies, Nike swoosh, CK). Ecstasy is known to cause nausea, blurred vision, chills and/or sweating. Increases in heart rate and blood pressure, as well as seizures, are also possible with Ecstasy. This can lead to muscle breakdown and organ failure. Cardiovascular failure has been reported in some of the Ecstasy-related fatalities. After-effects can include sleep problems, anxiety and depression. Below are examples of Ecstasy tablets.
