ICYMI: Curbside clothing collection now available

In case you missed it! Back in September, the City of The Colony began a partnership with **Simple Recycling** to offer weekly curbside collection of clothing for recycling. The program is free of charge and simple to use:



Step 1: Place clothing, shoes and home goods into the orange bags provided by Simple Recycling.

Step 2: Place your bags at the curb on your scheduled collection day by 7 a.m. Simple Recycling materials should be placed on the ground near your recycling container. *Please do not place the bags inside or on top of trash or recycling containers.*

Step 3: A Simple Recycling truck will collect the bags and recycle the items for reuse. Additionally, Simple Recycling will leave behind additional replacement bags for future use upon collection. Please note, only items placed inside the bags will be collected.

For every bag Simple Recycling collects, a new bag will be left behind. Usually they are tied to the handle of a refuse bin. Additional bags can be made available by visiting simple-recycling.com/supplies, calling 866-835-5068 or emailing info@simplerecycling.com.

Council Happenings

During its recent regular meetings, The Colony City Council:

- elected Place 3 Council member **Brian Wade as Deputy Mayor Pro Tem** and Place 1 Council member **Kirk Mikulec as Mayor Pro Tem**;

- approved issuance of **Certificates of Obligation** not to exceed \$14.9M for a wide variety of infrastructure projects;

- approved a Specific Use Permit for a day care center at **Soul Thirst Church** at Nash Drive and Main Street;

- approved development plan for **Cigars International**, to be located at the northwest corner of Plano Parkway and NFM Drive within Grandscape;

- approved three-year license agreement for **GIS services** in the amount of \$105K;

- approved noise variance for **Topgolf**, which intends to set off a brief fireworks show on New Years Eve. Council sought assurances representatives of Topgolf would communicate the event and variance to the nearby hotel; and,

- approved city council meeting schedule for 2018.
