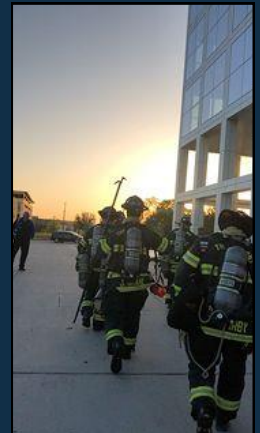


VOA-LPGA Texas Classic underway at Old American

The wait is over! It's time for the **Volunteers of America LPGA Texas Classic** to tee off at the **Old American Golf Club** in The Colony. The first round of the official tournament begins Thursday, May 3, with additional rounds each day through Sunday, May 6. Gates open at 7 a.m. Thursday and Friday, and at 8 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. The event will be broadcast live on the **Golf Channel**. Attendees are encouraged to download the official app of the LPGA for your smartphone, **LPGA Now**, to follow all the action. **Tickets are available online** at \$15/day or \$25/week. Children under 17 admitted free with ticketed adult. Parking is \$5. Visit the **official tournament website** for more information.

TCFD participates in high-rise drills

In conjunction with seven other regional departments, **The Colony Fire Department** participated in a series of high-rise drills March 6 to April 11 at a newly constructed building along SH121. The scenario involved a fire on the seventh floor. Crews had to locate the fire, work through the building systems, search and operate command, all the while coordinating closely with the other participating departments. TCFD logged about 180 hours of training. Drills such as these become more important as the city grows not only out but *up*. The Colony Fire Department crews prepared for three months prior to the drills and command staff were pleased with how they performed.



City did not violate testing standards



The City of The Colony did not violate **Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)** source-water monitoring requirements last year, as recently reported by local news. The violation referenced in the news report resulted from a clerical/reporting error that was corrected by the TCEQ in January 2018 to reflect that the City of The Colony was not, in fact, in violation of source-water monitoring requirements.
