









HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS FROM THE COLONY POLICE DEPARTMENT

-  Feed children before they start trick-or-treating! Tell them to wait until returning home to gobble the goodies.
-  Go with your children as they trick-or-treat. Visit only family, friends, and neighbors whom you know.
-  Inspect the treats before letting children help themselves. Look for wrappers that are torn, punctured or discolored. Inspect the candy inside to be sure that it too is intact.
-  Discard home-made treats unless you know and trust the people who made them.
-  Contact law enforcement officials if you think that someone has tampered with candy or other goodies.
-  Have a flashlight or glow stick available for each child that is trick-or-treating with you. This allows the child to see where they are going and for you and other people/motorists to see them.

The Colony Police Dept offers a free service to scan your bag of candy for metal objects. Just bring the bag to the station at 5151 N. Colony Blvd. **If you think that your child has been poisoned, call 911 immediately.
